INVITATION FOR BIDS Town of Superior Highway 371-Pedestrian Path Project Notice is hereby given that the Town of Superior (Town), Wyoming will receive sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary for construction of approximately 1,380 linear feet of 5-foot wide concrete sidewalk. The work consists of construction of a 5-ft. wide by 4-inch thick concrete sidewalk over 4-inches of compacted road base, excavation and embankment to finished grades, traffic control during construction, installation of traffic signs, and painting a crosswalk as called for in the Project Manual for the Town of Superior Highway 371 - Pedestrian Path Project. The Town will receive sealed bids at the Superior Administration Building, 3 North Main Street, Superior, Wyoming 82945 until 1:00 p.m. Local Time, on the 19th day of March, 2020, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids must be furnished on forms supplied in the Project Manual. Sealed envelopes containing bids shall be clearly marked with the project title and shall show the name and address of the Bidder. Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. The Town reserves the right to reject any and all bids and the right to waive irregularities in bids received. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient surety, or a certified check or cashiers check, or bank draft of a reputable bank, for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid, payable to, and to be forfeited to, the Town of Superior as liquidated damages if bidder fails to enter into contract within ten (10) days after award to him, or fails, at the time of executing the agreement, to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid. This project is generally described as Phase 1 of 2 of the BPHS Sidewalk Replacement and Heating System Improvements, which is located at 916 Piney Drive, Big Piney, WY. The Phase 1 project consists of demolition and replacement of approximately 11,600 SF of concrete sidewalk and 9,200 SF of concrete entrance pad. The 6,000+- SF front entrance also includes installation of approximately 14,000 LF of hydronic tubing and control manifolds for a snowmelt system. The Phase 2 project includes installation of the boilers and hydronic piping from the boilers to the outer wall of the building.
