TOWN OF MEDICINE BOW STREET AND DRAINAGE STRUCTURES PHASE 1 – MAPLE STREET The Town of Medicine Bow is seeking bids to provide construction services for the reconstruction of Maple Street along with installation of related storm drainage facilities and miscellaneous utility adjustments. The project consists of regrading and placing a compacted road base on approximately 42,000 square yards of existing roadway, installing new storm sewer system consisting of approximately 3,000 lineal feet of Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) of sized ranging from 12" to 36" and 18 manholes/box inlets, and moving adjusting utilities as needed. Road work includes furnishing all labor, materials, and equipment necessary. For storm drainage facilities the owner will provide all materials except bedding, so work includes only labor, equipment, and bedding. This project is funded by the Town of Medicine Bow. Bids will be received up until 1:00 pm on June 8, 2020 at the Medicine Bow Town Hall, 319 Pine Street, (P.O. Box 156 if mailing USPS), Medicine Bow, Wyoming, 82329 at which time they will be publicly opened and read aloud. Notice is hereby given that the Eden Valley Solid Waste Disposal District (Owner) will receive sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary for the Eden Valley Landfill Closure (Project). The Project consists of construction of a water balance cover including excavation of onsite borrow soils, subgrade preparation, installation of a final cover system (42-inches of lightly compacted classified fill and 6-inches of uncompacted topsoil) over routine or intermediate cover already in place (prepared subgrade). Also included with the project is construction of and installation of pan lysimeters for soil water column measurements and observation. The described system will cover a former municipal solid waste landfill footprint that encompasses approximately 25.20 acres. The Project is located approximately 1 mile southeast of Farson, Wyoming, in Township 25 North, Range 106 West, Section 34. All bids must be furnished on forms supplied in the Project Manual. Sealed
