The project site is in southcentral Wyoming 63 miles South of Rawlins, WY. The project consists of stream restoration and habitat improvements to 21,200 linear feet of Savery Creek directly downstream of High Savery Reservoir. Restoration activities generally include improving the width to depth ratio of the channel, installing rock or log vane structures as well as toe wood bank treatments and transplanting onsite vegetation for bioengineering. The restoration work will occur in four (4) phases; most of phase one (1) was completed last year. The next four phases will take place over the next three (3) to four (4) years. The length of restoration work each year/phase ranging from 3,500 feet to 6,600 feet. Channel work, each year, will need to start after September 1st and be completed by late October.
