DESCRIPTION OF WORK The work includes, but is not limited to, replacing existing domestic water piping with new. Removing existing galvanized domestic water piping and disposing of it per local, state, and federal codes. Replacement of two boilers and the existing domestic hot water tank with new. Ceiling and walls are to be removed and reinstalled for access to all domestic water piping in the building. Seismic requirements are required for the installation for the domestic hot water piping

Bids will be accepted until 10 a.m. on 27 May, 2021 at the Cheyenne Housing Authority office located at 3304 Sheridan Street, Cheyenne, WY 82009, at which time bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. Proposed forms of contract documents and specifications are on file at the Cheyenne Housing Authority office, 3304 Sheridan Street, Cheyenne, WY 82009, 307 633-8319. Attention is called to the provisions for equal employment opportunity, bonding requirements, and Davis Bacon wage rate regulations set forth in the specifications which must be paid on this project. Special attention shall be drawn to the provisions of Minority Business and Women owned enterprise, according to the conditions stated in HUD Form 5369A. A 5% bid bond must be included if the proposal is equal to or greater than \$25,000.00. Pursuant to W.S. 16-6-104, Wyoming materials and products of equal quality and desirability shall have preference over materials or products produced outside the State. Note: Due to regulations governing the federal financial assistance involved in this project, preference for resident Wyoming laborers, workmen and mechanics under W.S. 16-6-104 and W.S. 16-6-203 does not apply. INVITATION TO BID SUNDANCE KID TANK AND WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT Notice is hereby given that the City of Sundance (City), Wyoming will receive sealed bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary for: Construction of a 199,000-gallon, glass-coated (or approved equal AWWA D103 coating system), bolted steel water storage tank with concrete foundation and associated ductile iron piping, appurtenances, grading, and security fencing; improvements within one existing pump station including replacement of existing pumps, interior piping, valves and appurtenances with a new skid-mounted pump system; installation of approximately 2,600 linear feet (lf) of 10-inch poly-vinyl chloride (PVC) water transmission line through conventional trenching methods, approximately 15 lf of 8-inch PVC water transmission line, and 30 lf of 6-inch PVC water transmission line; approximately 820 lf of boring with 20-inch steel casing; demolition of two existing tanks (one above ground and one below ground); and all associated work to complete these services. Construction will include tank foundation and tank construction; grading; trench excavation; dewatering, pipe installation, bedding, backfill and compaction; installation of valves, pumps and appurtenances, traffic control, revegetation, and site restoration. These services are as called for in the Project Manual for the CITY OF SUNDANCE - SUNDANCE KID TANK AND WATER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT. The City will receive sealed bids at City Hall, 213 Main Street, P.O. Box 542, Sundance, Wyoming 82729 until 2:00 P.M. Local Time, on the 18th day of May 2021, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids must be furnished on forms supplied in the Project Manual. Sealed envelopes containing bids shall be

clearly marked with the project title and shall show the name and address of the Bidder. Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. The City reserves the right to reject any bids and to waive irregularities in bids received. Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient surety for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid, payable to, and to be forfeited to, the City of Sundance as liquidated damages if bidder fails to enter into contract within thirty (30) days after award to him, or fails, at the time of executing the agreement, to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid. Facsimile (fax) or other copies of bonds are not acceptable, nor are certified cashier's checks, certified checks or bank drafts. NO BID WILL BE CONSIDERED IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY SUCH BOND OR IF NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF W.S. 15-1-113. Pursuant to W.S. 16-6-106, "preference is hereby given to materials, supplies, agricultural products, equipment, machinery and provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to articles offered by competitors outside of the state". Qualified Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBEs) are encouraged to submit bids on this project. Bidders that use a subcontractor(s)/supplier(s) are required to make a good faith effort at soliciting DBE subcontractor/supplier participation. Bidders shall submit the required DBE Good Faith Effort Documentation form and other related forms with their bids. The procurement will be subject to the "Use of American Iron and Steel" requirements as contained in Section 436 of H.R. 3547, The Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2014 and as updated and revised in America's Water Infrastructure Act of 2018. This login and deposit will ensure that the plan holders are identified and supplied the possible addendum and notices associated with the project. A mandatory pre-bid conference and site tour will be held at 1:00 P.M. on April 27, 2021, at the City of Sundance City Hall, 213 Main Street, Sundance, Wyoming, at which attendance in person by Bidders is mandatory.
