Project Description: The University is seeking a qualified General Contractor and parking structure concrete firms for the construction of a multi-story parking garage on the Ivinson parking lot site. This will be a stone clad, cast-in-place, post tensioned concrete structure with an approved construction budget of \$16,667,320. The responses shall be submitted by the General Contractor, by Parking Structure Concrete Firms and by Masonry/Stone Services will require prequalification of both the general contractor and structural concrete firms. Parking Structure Concrete firms may or may not perform the concrete slab on grade work. Concrete flatwork firms are not required to be pre-qualified, but must be qualified to perform the work.
