A pre-bid conference will be held at 1:00 p.m. local time on Thursday, June 17, 2021 at the Sublette County Public Library, 155 S Tyler Ave, Pinedale, WY 82941 in the Board Room. Attendance at the pre-bid conference is highly encouraged but is not mandatory. Construction of approx. 3,450 SY of 8-foot wide ADA accessible asphalt pathway, two prefabricated pedestrian bridges, area of bank stabilization along the Pine Creek and other misc. work to be completed.
