

Invitations to Bid

The State Construction Department of the State of Wyoming, Procurement Section, will receive bids until 1:00 p.m. on August 27, 2021, for the Wyoming Game and Fish Department pre-cast concrete vault restrooms at the Anvil Draw Recreation Area and Raymond Mountain Public Access Area.

Project Description:

- Construct, remove old double outhouse / tank and haul to an approved landfill, excavate, deliver, and install a double precast concrete vault restroom, consistent with Federal GSA standards, at the Anvil Draw access area at the Flaming Gorge Reservoir approximately 2.7 miles on Forest Service Road 101 from intersection with Wyoming State Hwy 530 around 10 miles North of Manila, Utah. Lat - 109.334 Long - 41.430.
- Construct, deliver, and install a single precast concrete vault restroom, consistent with Federal GSA standards, at the Raymond Mountain Public Access Area approximately 8 miles north, of Cokeville, Wyoming. Lat -42.194 Long - 111.007 W.

Pre-Bid Meeting:

- No mandatory site visits are required, but bidders should be aware that the access roads to some of the installation sites are gravel roads with hills and may be difficult for some vehicles.

Bid documents available by logging on to Public Purchase at www.publicpurchase.com.

Only bids submitted through the Public Purchase site and on State of Wyoming forms will be considered.

It is the bidder's responsibility to review, through Public Purchase at www.publicpurchase.com for answers to questions, addenda, or bid tabulations.

Telephone calls, emails, or faxes may not be accepted.

A bid security of 10% of the total Bid Price will be required of all Bidders or an electronic bid bond with Surety 2000.

Notice is hereby given that the City of Laramie, Wyoming will receive electronic bids for the furnishing of all labor, materials, tools, appliances, transportation, and services necessary to complete the Baler Building Loading Dock as called for in the Project Manual and generally described as follows:

Improved site for a loading dock at the City landfill. The work includes partial demolition of the existing concrete pad. The proposed work includes a new retaining wall with a new concrete pad. The existing retaining wall will be removed by City staff. Contractor to coordinate with City staff on timing of retaining wall removal.

Electronic bids shall be submitted online until 1:00 PM Local Time, on the 31st day of August 2021, at which time the bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. All bids must be furnished electronically through the QuestCDN VirtuBid platform. Instructions for online bidding using QuestCDN have been attached as part of the Instructions to Bidders document. Bids which are not prepared and filed in accordance with the Instructions to Bidders may be rejected. The City reserves the right to reject any and all bids and the right to waive irregularities in bids received.

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid bond with sufficient surety, for not less than five percent (5%) of the total amount of such bid, payable to, and to be forfeited to, the City of Laramie as liquidated damages if bidder fails to enter into contract within thirty (30) days after award to him, or fails, at the time of executing the agreement, to furnish a performance bond and a payment bond each in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the bid. Facsimile (fax) or other copies of bonds are not acceptable. **NO BID WILL BE CONSIDERED IF NOT ACCOMPANIED BY SUCH BOND, OR IF NOT IN CONFORMANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS OF W.S. 15-1-113.**

A complete set of the Project Manual and Plans may be downloaded after the 14th day of August 2021, via the City website <http://www.cityoflaramie.com/projects/>, which will lead to a QuestCDN website, where the bidder must login and pay a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25). This login and deposit will ensure that the plan holders are identified and supplied the possible addendum and notices associated with the project.

A pre-bid conference shall be held at 1:15 PM on the 24th Day of August 2021, at the Laramie Landfill, 162 Roger Canyon Rd., Laramie, WY 82072, at which attendance by Bidders is Mandatory.

provisions produced, manufactured or grown in Wyoming, or supplied by a resident of the state, quality being equal to articles offered by the competitors outside of the state.

An OPTIONAL pre-bid meeting will be held at 10:00 AM, on August 20, 2021, in Room 205 of the Municipal Building at 2101 O'Neil Ave, Cheyenne, WY.

Bid guarantee in the amount of 5% of the total bid must accompany any bid submitted. The 5% bid guarantee may be in the form a bid bond secured and issued by a surety or guaranty company authorized to do business in the State of Wyoming or a cashier's check made payable to the City of Cheyenne.

The successful bidder shall furnish and pay for satisfactory performance and payment bonds in the amount of one hundred percent (100%) of the accepted bid. A surety bond is required for contracts over \$150,000.00.

Provisions of Wyoming Statute 15-1-113 are, by reference, made an express part of the contract documents. The City reserves the right to reject any or all bids and to waive any formalities in the bidding.
